

Hi Coaches:

We cannot tell you WHO you will be playing on Sunday, but we can give you approximate times and courts you will be playing on. If you refer to the tournament grid, you will see a grade level and a division number (if the grade level has enough teams to fill multiple divisions such as the B8 division. We cannot tell you at this time , who will be in what division until all scores are reported. Let's look at an example of the B9 division. The B9 (Boys 9<sup>th</sup> grade) division has 14 teams in it. Division 1 will have the top eight teams in it and Division 2 will have 6 teams in it. The B9 Division 1 teams will play on Courts 5-8 at 11 am. We will not know who you play, but we will know when you play. We will figure out who you play later tonight after all scores are reported. The B9 Division 2 teams will have 6 teams in it. Two teams will get byes and advance to the B9 Division 2 semifinals at 1 pm on courts 5 and 6. The other 4 teams will play first round games at 9 am on Courts 8 and 9; with the two winners of those games also advancing to the semifinals.

QUESTION: How do we know whether we are a Division 1 or Division 2 team?

ANSWER: You will not know that until after all results are accumulated. We expect to have postings made until late tonight. Right now we can tell you where those divisions will play their games at and what times.
